



## **Outreach Specialist Job Description**

Austin LifeGuard Character & Sexuality Education (ALG) is an abstinence and character-based pregnancy prevention education program of Austin LifeCare (ALC). Austin LifeCare is a local, faith-based nonprofit that provides compassionate and practical services for the difficult issues surrounding unexpected pregnancy. These include prevention education, pregnancy support and services, and abortion recovery programs.

**Principle Functions:** The Outreach Specialist is responsible for ensuring that all Austin LifeGuard services are culturally sensitive.

**Reports to:** Austin LifeGuard Director

### **Minimum Requirements:**

- Have a bachelor's degree, preferably in a helping field, or related experience equivalent
- Two years of experience working with diverse populations
- Must be a team player
- Agree with and be able to uphold the Austin LifeCare Statement of Faith
- Must be willing to travel

### **Responsibilities:**

- Adapts all classroom curriculums, after school programs, teen leadership programs, and parent workshops to be culturally sensitive and age appropriate for maximum effectiveness
- Coordinates presentations to special and unreached populations and organization
- Actively recruits community partnerships with unreached organizations
- Identifies and arranges speaking opportunities to at-risk teen populations in the Austin area
- Recruits teenagers from diverse backgrounds to participate on the Teen Leadership Council
- Adapts the public education campaign, web site, and print resources to be culturally sensitive and age appropriate
